HE THEN POINTED THE MOCK RIFLE AT POLICE WHICH PROMPTED S-D-P-D SGT. KERRY MENSIOR TO OPEN FIRE.

POLICE DO *NOT* KNOW WHAT CAUSED CHESNEY'S ACTIONS...BUT PEOPLE WHO KNEW HIM SAID HE HAD BEEN IN A SUICIDAL STATE OF MIND ON THE MORNING OF HIS DEATH.

25-YEAR-OLD EMILIO AREZANAS IS THE FOURTH MAN SENTENCED FOR THE MURDER OF AGENT ROBERT ROSAS.

THE GROUP OF MEN ATTEMPTED TO STEAL NIGHT VISION GOGGLES FROM ROSAS WHILE HE WAS IN THE CAMPO DESERT.

HE RESISTED AND WAS SHOT 9 TIMES.

THE THREE OTHER MEN WERE PREVIOUSLY SENTENCED TO 40, 55 AND 56 YEARS IN PRISON.

A FIFTH MAN REMAINS AT LARGE BUT POLICE BELIEVE HE MAY BE DEAD.
